Richard Dahl named next chief executive of James Campbell Co.

The James Campbell Co. has hired Richard Dahl, the former president and COO of Bank of Hawaii, to be its next chief executive, effective Aug. 11.

Dahl is replacing Steve MacMillan, who has been with the Hawaii-based real estate company for more than 28 years. He announced his retirement in May 2009.

Dahl was with **Bank of Hawaii Corp.** for more than 20 years, including stints as president and chief operating officer from 1994 to 2002. He also has been director of **Victoria Ward Ltd.** and, in 2002, Dahl went to the Mainland to be president and COO of **Dole Food Co.**

Dahl is also currently the nonexecutive chairman of **International Rectifier Corp.** (NYSE: IRF) of El Segundo, Calif., and is a director of **DineEquity Inc.** (NYSE: DIN) of Glendale, Calif., **IDACORP Inc.** and **Idaho Power Co.** (NYSE: IDA) of Boise, Idaho.

In early 2007, the Estate of James Campbell distributed its assets to 31 beneficiaries of the late James Campbell to comprise what is now known as the James Campbell Co. At the time, the newly formed company had a real estate portfolio valued at \$2.6 billion. It is one of Hawaii's largest private real estate companies.
