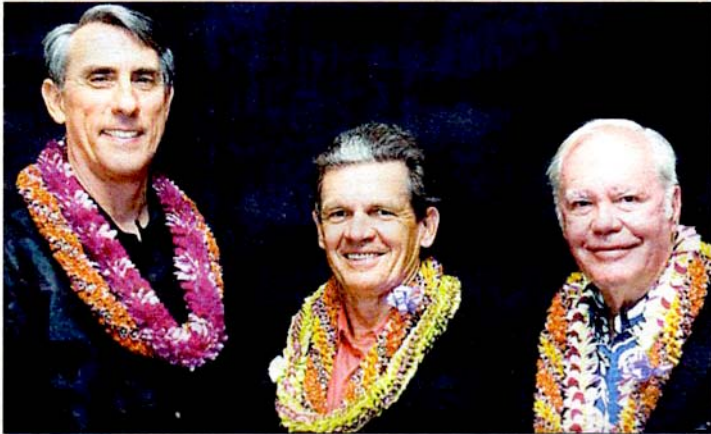

## Estate trustees earn achievement award

**KAPOLEI** — The Hawaii Chapter of the National Association of Industrial and Office Properties (NAIOP) recently presented the trustees of the Estate of James Campbell with its Holo Pono Lifetime Achievement Award.
